**ELECTION EQUIPMENT TESTING TO ENSURE ACCURACY**  
Public Test of Vote by Mail Counting Equipment on April 30, 2021

The May 4th Special by Mail Only Election is underway for County Service Area P-2 Zone B (Alamo) in Contra Costa County. The public is invited to observe testing of the equipment used to count ballots.

Logic and accuracy testing is a standard pre-election procedure. Central-count voting equipment is used to tally all vote-by-mail ballots and the public test of the equipment will begin at 10:00 am Friday, April 30th at the Elections Office, located at 555 Escobar Street in Martinez.

The Special Election is for approximately 8,000 voters in County Service Area P-2 Zone B in Alamo who are voting on a single ballot measure. The test will confirm that all machines are in working order and functioning properly. A set of test ballots will be scanned through each machine to ensure they are properly programmed and operating as expected.

Visitors are asked to check-in at the Elections lobby. Everyone entering the building for the Logic & Accuracy Test is required to wear a mask and observe social distancing guidelines. For more information, call 925-335-7800.

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
